Donald M. Towle, 80 years young, of Topeka, passed away Wednesday, May 21, 2014. Don was born September 14, 1933, in Topeka to Winifred (Brouette) and Bernard Towle. He married Adeline Moberly on June 19, 1954, at Holy Name Catholic Church. Don graduated Summa Cum Laude from Washburn University, June 5, 1966, while managing a local grocery store. He survived the grocery store collapsing around him during the June 8, 1966, tornado. Soon after he started a new career with Kansas Bankers Surety Company. During his 46 year tenure he grew the company from a local Kansas company to a publicly traded Berkshire Hathaway subsidiary before retiring as President and CEO on December 31, 2013. Don loved Adeline and they held hands every time they could. Together they traveled the world, visiting 65 countries on six continents. When they were not traveling they cherished spending time with their children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren sharing the stories of their adventures. Don's hobby was sailing and he raised his family at the Shawnee Yacht Club. He served in many capacities including Commodore. For the last several years, Don and Adeline ran the Race Committee which officiates sailboat races. He was so proud of his Irish heritage that he became a citizen of Ireland, as well as being a citizen of the United States of America. He often stated, "I am glad I don't get all the government I pay for."
