December 10, 1929 - June 29, 2023

Earl F. Kintner, 93, Topeka, Kansas, passed away Thursday, June 29, 2023.

Earl was born December 10, 1929, in Elkhart, Kansas, the son of Earl and Thelma Greaser Kintner. He grew up in Minneola, Kansas where his family owned a grocery store. He graduated from Minneola High School where he developed a love for acting.

Earl enlisted in the Navy in 1950, serving in the Korean War. He was wounded in the battle on Bunker Hill in 1952 and awarded the Purple Heart.

On November 22, 1952, Earl and Lillian Faye Wilson were united in marriage in Memphis, Tennessee, enjoying 68 years together prior to her death August 5, 2020.

Earl was a photographer for the State of Kansas for 31 years using those skills to photograph weddings and individual portraits as well. Beginning in 1964, Earl and his family were involved in Santa Claus pictures, from the week before Thanksgiving until Christmas Eve, with the last few years at White Lakes Mall. Earl loved to travel with his wife and her sister, Mattie, and play pool, golf and roller skate. He loved his family dearly and will be greatly missed.

Grateful to have shared Earl's life are his children, Sheila Holt. (Dale), Bruce Kintner and Mary Ann Fulton; seven grandchildren and 15 great-grandchildren. He was also preceded in death by his parents and his brother.
