Edgar Joseph “Ed” Boos, 74, Topeka, Kansas, passed away Tuesday, September 20, 2022.

Ed was a life-long Topekan, born March 13, 1948, the son of Edgar and Mary Stein Boos. He was a 1966 graduate of Hayden High School and attended Washburn University before being drafted into the Army, serving our country in Vietnam. In 1984, Ed and Stacey Lynn Kenney were united in marriage, enjoying 38 years together.

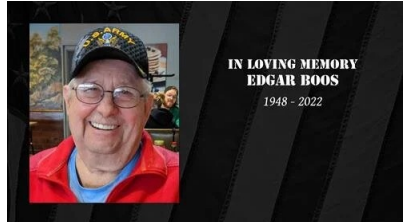
