Edna was a registered nurse and served as a 1st Lieutenant in the Army Nurse Corps during World War II. After discharge from the Army, she worked in different hospitals in Denver, CO and Topeka, KS and retired from Memorial Hospital in Topeka, KS. She was a member of the St. Francis Hospital Ladies Auxillary, American Legion Capital Post #1, and did volunteer work for the American Red Cross and the Ring-A-Day program in Topeka.
