Edward B. Lambrecht, 81, Topeka, passed away Monday, March 17, 2014. Ed was born June 28, 1932, the son of John and Rose Desch Lambrecht. He proudly served our country in the US Army in Korea from 1952-1954. On May 7, 1955, Ed and Mary Ann Kamer were united in marriage, enjoying over 58 years together. Ed worked for Goodyear Tire and Rubber for 43 years, retiring in 1994. He was a member of Mater Dei Parish and the Knights of Columbus, Council No. 2608.
