



## Elsiann Patterson

Elsiann Patterson, 86, Topeka, Kansas, passed away peacefully at her home on July 9, 2024. She was born September 16, 1937, in Culver City, California, to Rosemary Chandler and Richard Quell.

Elsiann graduated from Washburn University in 1959, with a degree in Psychology. On June 21, 1959, she married Darrell “Pat” Patterson, and they celebrated 65 years together this year. Elsiann established her first business in 1972, Vehicle Title Service, giving prompt title service state-wide for 52 years. Later, she started a pet-boarding service, encouraged by her love of animals. Elsiann enjoyed family trips, one of her favorites was to Las Vegas for a renewal of her wedding vows for their 50th anniversary, officiated by “Elvis.” She especially has a love for New York City, visiting there often and with a trip planned in later September 2001. After 9/11, Elsiann actually went to the airport, to be turned away.

Elsiann was a smart, quirky, kind and fun-loving person. As her health declined, her attitude and love for life seemed to increase. Never complaining about her situation and dealing positively with what was handed her. Her body was donated to science, as she had planned early on.

Elsiann is survived by her husband, Pat Patterson, of the home; children, Rick Patterson (Julie), Marnie Patterson, and Jill Patterson, all of Topeka; four

grandchildren; five great-grandchildren; and her sister, Paula Quell (Larry Davis), of Merriam, Kansas.
