April 3, 1918 - April 6, 2005

Esther Mae Wurtz, 87, was called home to be with the Lord on Wednesday, April 6, 2005.

Esther was born April 3, 1918 in Nelson, Nebraska to Charles and Estella Rouse Haidsiack.
