



## Eugene Nicholas Disidore

June 11, 1926 - November 12, 2018

Eugene Nicholas Disidore, 92, Topeka, Kansas, died Monday, November 12, 2018.

Eugene was born June 11, 1926, to his Italian parents, Antonio and Mary Immarino Disidore, in Fort Wayne, Indiana. Gene cherished his Catholic upbringing and deep love of God and country. He served four years in the US Army during WWII and was honorably discharged.

Gene was vice president of Modern Office Methods and managed the 3M Products Center in Topeka. Later he became owner of Systems & Services of Kansas.

Gene loved his wife of 63 years, Bonnie Schemehorn Disidore; his ten children, John, Jeff, Karen, Christina (Joe), Nicholas (Jeanne), Maria (Doug), Jonella, Thomas (Kelli), Gina and Tony (Sonya); his 17 grandchildren and six great-grandchildren; sister, Dolores Doehring.
