



## Eugenia "Jean" Weishaar

January 12, 1918 - February 27, 2004

Jean Weishaar, 86, died suddenly Friday, February 27, 2004 in Topeka of complications following an aneurysm. She was born January 12, 1918, the daughter of Joseph and Helen Gamalski Figlock in Detroit, Michigan.

Jean grew up in Detroit as the youngest member of her family. She had two brothers and two sisters, who all preceded her in death. She married Joseph Clayton Weishaar of Nortonville, Kansas on October 21, 1943. They met in Detroit, where Joe was being trained for World War II. The wedding was in Florence, South Carolina, where Joe was sent for further training. He preceded her in death on March 23, 1980. After the war she moved, she said, "From the fourth largest city in the United States to the fourth smallest."

They became long-time residents of Valley Falls, KS, where Jean was a member of the Altar Society at St. Mary's Catholic Church and of the P.E.O. Sorority. After Joe's death, Jean moved to Topeka, where she was a member of Christ the King Catholic Church. She was a volunteer at St. Francis Hospital for over 15 years. Jean also belonged to several bridge clubs in Valley Falls and Topeka.

Jean is survived by three daughters and one son: Mary Atchley and her husband Bob, of Topeka; Betsy Kelly and her husband Steve, of Lawrence; Margaret Peterson and her husband Chuck, of Lawrence; and Tom Weishaar

and his wife Kathleen O'Connell of New York City.

She had eight grandchildren - Molly Weishaar, Joseph Weishaar, Rob Messinger, Austin Kelly, Tiffany Peterson, Lauren Kelly, Bryant Peterson, and Lindsay Kelly - as well as numerous nieces and nephews.

Mrs. Weishaar will lie in state from 4 to 8 pm on Monday, March 1, 2004 at Kevin Brennan Family Funeral Home, 2801 SW Urish Road, Topeka, KS 66614, with a parish rosary at 7:30 and family visitation from 6 to 8. Mass of Christian Burial will be Tuesday March 2, 2004 at 10:00 AM at Christ The King Catholic Church with burial to follow at St. Joseph's Catholic Cemetery in Nortonville. In lieu of flowers, memorial contributions may be made to the St. Francis Critical Care Unit through the Funeral Home.
