Fayette "Mickey" Loehr, 79, died Friday July 23, 2004 at Midland Hospice House.

Mrs. Loehr was born October 1, 1924 in Gypsum, KS the daughter of Fred Melvin and Elizabeth Major Sloop.

Mrs. Loehr attended elementary school in Carlton, Kansas and attended Carlton High School, Abilene High in Abilene, and graduated from Dickinson County Community High School in Chapman.

She moved to Topeka in 1952 and worked for Sears Credit Dept., then operated the Dinner Bell Café and later sold furniture for Ed Marling's Store.

She married Gordon Pingree in 1953. He died January 23, 1973. Mickey married John D. Loehr on May 9, 1975. He survives.
