FRANCIS ANDREW 'FRANK' RAAB Francis Andrew Raab, 89, Topeka, joined Our Lord on February 10, 2012. He was born on August 3, 1922 in Topeka, KS, to Carl and Josephine (Baum) Raab. He was raised on a farm and attended school in the Valencia area. He served in the U.S. Army in WWII and received two Purple Hearts and a Bronze Star for acts of courage in the Invasion of Normandy and the Battle of the Bulge. He was married to Alice Juanita Keller in the Assumption Church in Topeka KS on April 30, 1946, after his return from military duty. He was a member of Most Pure Heart of Mary Church and the American Legion Capital Post #1. He retired from Colmery-O'Neil VA Medical Center in 1977 after 31 years of service. He was preceded in death by his parents. Survivors include his wife Juanita and son, Gerald L. Raab and his wife Jamey. During retirement, he and his wife enjoyed boating, fishing and camping in Kansas, and many happy winters in Texas with their friends. He will be greatly missed by his family and friends and always remembered for his courage, strength, wisdom and sense of humor. He will lie in state from 4:30-6:00 p.m. Tuesday, February 14, 2012 at Kevin Brennan Family Funeral Home, 2801 SW Urish Rd., Topeka KS; where a parish rosary will be prayed at 6 p.m. Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated 10 a.m. Wednesday, February 15, 2012 at Most Pure Heart of Mary Church, 3601 SW 17th St., Topeka KS, and burial will follow at Mount Calvary Cemetery, Topeka KS.
