



Freddie R. Schoenfeld

May 9, 1928 - July 8, 2016

Freddie R. Schoenfeld, 88, Topeka, passed away Friday, July 8, 2016.

Fred was born May 9, 1928, in Topeka KS, the oldest of seven children born to Clarence E. (Red) and Mary C. Hefner Schoenfeld. Fred attended St. Joseph Church and Grade School, graduated from Capitol Catholic High School (now Hayden Catholic High) in 1946 and then joined the Navy. On May 12, 1952, Fred and Nina Stebbins were married at St. Joseph Church.

Fred and Nina were founding members of Christ the King Church. He was an usher and worked on the fund raising committees. He was a past member of the American Society of Germans from Russia Club, a volunteer and charter member of the Shawnee County Hunter Education and served as a master instructor, range master, and area coordinator. He was a member of the American Legion, Post #1 and was a life member of Plumbers Local 165, now known as Local #441. Fred's hobbies were gardening, wood working, fishing and hunting, coaching and umpiring Little League baseball.

Survivors include, his wife, Nina Schoenfeld; daughters, Karen Schiffelbein (John), Kenda Miller (Duane) of Topeka, Georgina Engler (Bruce) of Burlingame; son, Richard Schoenfeld (Mary) of Wamego; 11 grandchildren, 21 great-grandchildren, and six step-great-grandchildren; sisters Mary Ann Schoenfeld, Barbara Zupan, Kathleen Shephard; and brothers, Michael and

James Schoenfeld. He was preceded in death by his parents and a brother, Kenneth.

Mr. Schoenfeld will lie in state on Tuesday from 1 p.m. until 7 p.m. Tuesday at Kevin Brennan Family Funeral Home, 2801 SW Urish Road, Topeka KS 66614. A rosary will be prayed at 5 p.m. Tuesday at the funeral home, where family will greet friends until 7 p.m.

Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Wednesday at St. Joseph Church. Burial will follow in Mt. Calvary Cemetery.

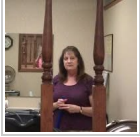
