Gene Francis Meyer, 61, Topeka, Kansas passed away Friday, September 29, 2017, in Colorado Springs, Colorado.

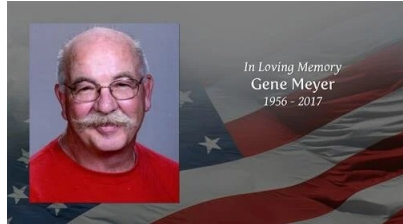
