George Schiefelbein, 87, Topeka, died Sunday, June 26, 2016, at his home.

George was born October 29, 1928, in Topeka KS, the sixth of eleven children of Joseph and Amelia Wasinger Schiefelbein. He was baptized at St. Joseph Church and attended St. Joseph Grade School. On May 20, 1950, George and Sophia Gartner were united in marriage at St. Joseph Church. She died April 2, 2003.

George served in the US Army during WWII. He was a graduate of the Industrial Training Institute of Chicago, Illinois then was employed as a carpenter. He was a member of Local No. 1445. George worked for and retired from McCormick Rug and Bob Florence Contractor. He was a member of the American Legion, VFW, a lifetime member of the Moose Lodge No. 555 and past governor from 1995-1996. He was a charter member of the American Historical Society of Germans from Russia.

Survivors include his children, Joseph Schiefelbein (Ginger), Nancy White (Larry) and Rebecca Schiefelbein; grandchildren, Amy Raines, Jason White, Andrew Schiefelbein, and Sara Gudenkauf; great-grandchildren, Violet and Olivia White, Kaden and Carter Raines and Miles Schiefelbein. George was preceded in death by all his brothers, Edward, Joseph, Sylvester and Eugene Schiefelbein and all his sisters, Amelia Summers, Mary Artzer, Anna Sales,

Helen Pfeiffer, Irene Gardner and Leona Montgomery.

Mr. Schiefelbein will lie in state from 10 to 1 p.m. Wednesday at Kevin Brennan Family Funeral Home, 2801 SW Urish Road, Topeka KS, where family will greet friends from 12 to 1 p.m.

Funeral service will be at 1 p.m. at the funeral home with burial following at Mt. Calvary Cemetery.
