Georgia Ann Riggin, 90, Topeka, Kansas, passed away Monday, March 30, 2020.

Georgia was born August 8, 1929, the youngest daughter of George and Margaret Ratcliff Reklites. On June 12, 1948, Georgia and Richard Wayne Riggin were united in marriage at the Central Park Christian Church. She later joined the First Baptist Church and attended every week until she was no longer able.
