



## Gerald "Jerry" Heinen

November 20, 1937 - May 2, 2025

Gerald "Jerry" Bernard Heinen, 87, passed away peacefully in the arms of his daughters, Brenda Sweezey and Tammy Koch, on Friday, May 2, 2025.

Jerry was born on November 20, 1937, in Seneca, Kansas, and graduated from St. Peter and Paul Catholic School in 1955. In 1956, he began his service in the United States Navy aboard the USS Gregory, serving in regions from Pearl Harbor to the waters off China and Japan. After his Honorable Discharge in 1962, Jerry dedicated over 40 years to the Kansas Department of Transportation as an engineer, where he played a significant role in shaping Kansas's highway design and infrastructure.

In retirement, Jerry continued to enjoy watching K-State athletics, pursued his passion for woodworking, and was a constant and proud presence at his grandchildren's sporting events and activities.

On November 24, 1959, Jerry married the love of his life, Janice "Jan" Sunneberg. They shared an inspiring 65 years of marriage. He leaves behind his beloved wife Jan and their daughters Brenda Sweezey (Mark) and Tammy Koch (Jeff).

Jerry was a devoted grandfather to Tyler Sweezey (Lindsey), Kyle Koch (Kaleigh), Dalton Sweezey, and Isaac Koch (Jenna), and a cherished great-

grandfather to Dalton “DJ” Sweezey Jr., Raylynn Sweezey, Aurelia Sweezey, and a future baby Sweezey expected soon.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Joe and Aurelia Heinen. He is survived by his sisters, Karen Rilinger (Paul - deceased), and Marilyn Evans (Gary); and many loving nieces and nephews.
