



## Gerald L. "Jerry" Schrempp

Gerald L. "Jerry" Schrempp, 61, of Topeka, passed away Mon. May 25, 2009 at Midland Hospice House. He was born Feb. 16, 1948 in Englewood, CO, the son of Donald J. and Clara B.
