Geraldine Mae Vanover, 87, of Topeka, Kansas, passed away peacefully Tuesday, July 16, 2019. She was born September 11, 1931, to Jack and Zelda Dick in Perry, Kansas. In 1952, she married the love of her life, Donald “Van” Vanover.

Gerri is survived by five children: Kathi Obendorfer (Michael), Lori McNish (Kenny Katz), Pam Schmidt (Charlie), Shelly Mackey (Mark), and Alan Vanover. She is also survived by thirteen grandchildren, twelve great-grandchildren; and her brother, Max Dick. Gerri was preceded in death by her beloved Van in 1987 and her twin siblings, Cliff Dick and Cleo Tillery.

Gerri blessed the community with her incredible music and fun filled energy for over seventy years. As a young woman, her music was heard by thousands of people live on the radio and at venues, often with her father Jack, who was a local saxophonist. She continued her entertainment career in Salina, Kansas and surrounding areas with the “Gerri Van Trio”. She created an album, which was a crowning moment in her career. Later on, she opened a night club/piano bar called “Gerri V’s”. It held a special place in her heart, as hundreds of musicians, including herself, sat and played there. Gerri’s children and grandchildren were her pride and joy. She adored her friends so much and never met a stranger. We will all miss her terribly and remember Gerri for her infectious smile, bold heart, and passion for life!

Geri's visitation will be Tuesday, July 23, from 5 to 7 p.m. at Kevin Brennan Family Funeral Home, 2801 SW Urish Road, Topeka KS 66614. Her funeral service will be at 10 a.m. Wednesday at Grace Episcopal Cathedral, 701 SW 8th Ave, Topeka KS 66603. Burial will follow at Memorial Park Cemetery.
