Gilbert P. "Punky" Gonzales, Jr., 62, Topeka, Kansas, passed away Monday, March 6, 2023.

Punky was born August 10, 1960, at Fort Campbell, Kentucky, the son of Gilbert, Sr. and Sheila McGinley Gonzales. He was a 1978 graduate of Hayden High School and attended Hutchinson Junior College. He was an accomplished cross country runner at both schools. Punky loved to play basketball, was a huge Miami Dolphins fan, and loved his Jayhawks. He thoroughly enjoyed coaching his children's teams as well.

Punky currently worked at Frito-Lay and many years ago had been a DJ both in Topeka and Florida. Music was a big part of his life. While in Florida, Punky also worked for the United States Postal Service.

Punky married Suzanne Bonadonna, July 31, 1993, in Fort Lauderdale, Florida and to this union three beautiful children were born, Nicholas, Jonathan and Rio. They later divorced.

Punky was a man of faith who really loved the Lord and was a member of Lakeview Church of the Nazarene.
