Regina Marie Riddle, 66, Topeka, passed away Monday, January 9, 2017.

Gina was born November 30, 1950, in Topeka, Kansas, the daughter of James and Regina Hurla Riddle. She attended Sacred Heart Catholic Grade School and graduated from Hayden High School in 1968.
