“ I met Greg at KU in Pharmacy school. We were both from Topeka, had many of the same classes together and we became friends. We studied together and after an “Organic Medicinal Agents” test we would celebrate by playing a game of pool. I always credited Greg for getting me through Pharmacy school. Both Greg and I were fanatical about our love for ethics, KU, KU athletics and the love for our country, We put many miles on my 1967 GTO going back and forth from Topeka and Lawrence. After graduating Greg convinced me to join the Kansas National Guard with him. I was married and thought that it would be a good option since the Viet Nam war was raging at the time. So we joined and six weeks later I’m in for six years and he’s out, not because of his heart murmur but because he had flat feet or something. I never let him live that down. Greg went to work for Super D and I joined my dad in our pharmacies. When Super D closed and we closed our stores we both worked for Dillon’s for 20 or so years. I told Greg that I would give him a ride in my GTO after it had been rebuilt and safe to drive. I regret that not happening because I didn’t know he was ill and thought we had plenty of time to get together. I’m sorry I had to type this letter but if I had written it you would not be able to read it because of my terrible hand writing. I blame it on trying to take notes too fast in pharmacy school.
