Gregory Clair Huseth, 60, of Topeka, passed away Monday, December 1, 2014, surrounded by his family, following a 23-year-battle with cancer. Greg was born on November 3, 1954, in Frankfurt, Germany, the son of Herbert and Mary (Manny) Huseth. Greg and his family moved to Topeka in 1968; and he graduated from Hayden High School in 1972. Greg also graduated from Kansas State University in 1977 with a BSBA in accounting. On September 23, 1989, Greg married Cornelia R. Daluz, M.D., at Assumption Catholic Church in Topeka. Greg was a CPA, licensed to practice in Kansas and Missouri, since 1983 and in sole proprietorship since 1993. Greg was a member of the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants, Kansas Society of Certified Public Accountants, a Registered Representative for Cambridge Investment Research and was an author and lecturer. Greg was an avid K-State fan and enjoyed watching sports. He also enjoyed traveling and loved spending time with his family. Greg was a warrior in battling his cancer. He always kept a positive attitude and refused to complain. He was dearly loved and will be sorely missed.
