Hans Andrew Weiter, 86, Topeka, passed away Wednesday, December 23, 2009. Hans was born June 15, 1923 in Bendorf, Germany, the son of George and Maria Frickel Weiter. He was a graduate of Capital Catholic High School in 1941 and the University of Kansas in 1949 with a degree in Pharmacology. On January 21, 1950, Hans and Mary Lou Levings were married at St. Joseph Church. Mr. Weiter served our country in the US Navy and US Marines during WWII as a corpsman in the Pacific Theater including the invasion of Iwo Jima and the occupation of Japan. He worked for Elkins Pharmacy for over 25 years before retiring. He was a member of Most Pure Heart of Mary Church.
