Harold David Hamilton, 71, Topeka, Kansas, passed away at his home Sunday, October 14, 2018, from pancreatic cancer.

David was born October 10, 1947, in Wamego, Kansas, the son of Everett and Mary Miller Hamilton. The family came to Topeka in 1960. David graduated from Our Lady of the Ozarks Oblate Seminary and earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Education from the University of Kansas. David was employed by AT&T from 1973 to 2001. On June 23, 1973, David and Linda Marie Swinney were united in marriage at St. Matthew Church enjoying 45 years together.

David enjoyed tennis and running, participating in 10 marathons. He was a man of deep faith. He loved God and his family. He was dearly loved and will be dearly missed.
