Harold G. Worswick passed away peacefully, May 5, 2013, at Midland Hospice House. Harold achieved his life goals and has joined his wife, Betty, and daughter, Karen, in Heaven. Harold was born December 22, 1925 to Lila (Nevin) and George Worswick. Brothers Ed, Alvin and Robert predeceased him. Sister, Melba Clemmer survives. Harold will be missed by son Mike (Debbie) Worswick; four grandchildren, Chad Harkness, Erin (Jeff) Sutton, Doug Worswick, Michelle (Scott) Dicus; and three great-grandchildren, Ethan Sutton, Austin Sutton, and Effy Dicus. Harold is loved by many members of his extended family with whom he has shared his life. Harold served in the US Army from 1944 – 1945 and was a proud World War II veteran. He owned and operated Wolfe's Camera and related companies for 40 years. In addition to five retail locations, Harold operated Wolfe's Commercial Photo Service. Harold was the pilot when Wolfe's provided complete aerial coverage of the 1951 Topeka flood. He started Wolfe's Copy Products Company which was a pioneer in the sales of office copy machines in a three-state area. Harold served as a director of Fidelity State Bank. He was a director of several mutual funds operated by Security Benefit. Harold was always actively involved in the Topeka community by participating in organizations like the Topeka Cosmopolitan Club, Junior Jaycees, and the Arab Shrine, where he was active in Greeters, Golfers, & Legion of Honor. He was a founder and later president of Topeka Sales and Marketing Executives. He founded and later served Downtown Topeka as president. He was a long

time member of the Topeka Parking Advisory board. Harold was a past president of Family Service and Guidance Center. He was a past president of Shawnee Country Club where he was a long time member. Betty and Harold were married on September 30, 1944. Their life together was a picture book love story to the very last day. Harold devoted the last several years of his life to caring for his wife, Betty.
