Helen Frances Boltz Davis, 82 years old, of Topeka passed away Monday, May 26, 2008 at Midland Hospice. She was born July 7, 1925 in Green Ridge, Missouri, the daughter of Emmett H. and Helen E. Habecker Boltz. Helen was a 1943 graduate of Green Ridge High School and attended Central Missouri State Teachers College in Warrensburg, Missouri. After graduating, Mrs. Davis taught in a one room school in Prairie View School District in Missouri. She was a charter member of the Green Ridge Rebekah Lodge No. 830 and a member of the Guiding Star Chapter No. 306 Order of the Eastern Star, also of Green Ridge. Mrs. Davis served as a Ruling Elder in the Green Ridge Presbyterian Church and taught Sunday school for many years. After moving to Topeka in the late 1980's, Mrs. Davis worked in the Registrar's Office at Washburn University, was a member of Trinity Presbyterian Church, and lived the last few years of her life at Presbyterian Manor in Topeka. She married Donald D. Davis on August 11, 1946 in Green Ridge, Missouri. They were later divorced. Mrs. Davis was preceded in death by a brother, Carl Wilson Boltz. She was a loving mother to daughters, Carol Parrett (Gary) and Jenelle Carkhuff (Sam) both of Topeka, and a son, Kenny Davis (Judy) of Lincoln, Missouri.
