Henry W. Babinsky Jr., 96, of Topeka, died on June 3, 2013. He was born in Newton, KS on September 6, 1916, the second son of Catherine (Hamilton) and Henry W. Babinsky. Henry attended Sacred Heart Grade School and graduated from Emporia High School. He attended the College of Emporia. In December 1940 his National Guard Company "B" was called to active duty with the 37th Regiment. 35th Division, Camp Robinson Arkansas.
