



## Herman Rodehorst

June 4, 1917 - March 20, 2006

Herman Ernst Walter Rodehorst, 88, Topeka, passed away, March 20, 2006.

Herman was born June 4, 1917, the son of Henry Rodehorst and his wife, Hilda Meier Rodehorst. He was baptized as an infant at St. John's Lutheran Church. He attended St. John's Lutheran School near Palmer and after graduation he helped his father on the farm. As a young man he was employed at the Washington Co. Co-op Creamery as a truck driver and also farmed. On Oct. 25, 1941 he was united in marriage to Renata Lehenbauer at St. John's Lutheran Church in Palmer, KS. In 1951 he moved to Topeka with his family where he worked at Goodyear Tire and Rubber Co. until his retirement in 1979. He was a member of Faith Lutheran Church.
