Rev. Hernando Palomares Marcelo, 82, Topeka, passed away March 12, 2012. Rev. Hernando was born October 28, 1929 in the Philippines the son of Manuel and Esther (Palomares) Marcelo. He married Conchita Martin on June 21, 1958 in the Philippines. He received his Master of Arts in Christian Education from Methodist Theological School in Ohio. He studied for his Doctorate at St. Paul Theological School. Rev. Hernando was a Methodist Church Minister. Prior to moving the United States he ministered at St. Peter UMC, Malabon Central UMC and Grace United Methodist Church in the Philippines. He began ministering in the US in Seattle at Ronald UMC and then was appointed to Whiting and Netawaka UMC in Kansas. He retired from Toronto United Methodist Church in 1995. He was a member of the First United Methodist Church in Topeka. Rev. Hernando enjoyed playing basketball, reading books and newspaper, gardening, fishing and walking in the mall with his wife. Survivors include his wife, Conchita Marcelo; five children, Amy (Emy) Cruz, Precy Marcelo, Rowena (Larry) Castro, Hernando, Jr. (Jenny) Marcelo and Stan (Edna) Marcelo. Other survivors include 14 grandchildren and one great-grandson. He was preceded in death by his parents, two brothers, and a sister.
