Howard Joel Dines, 72, longtime resident of Topeka, passed away Friday, November 4, 2005, at The Veteran's Hospital, Denver, CO.

Howard was born in Bronx, NY, December 22, 1932 to Murray and Rose Dines. Howard was married to Glennadean Elliott on March 29, 1968.

Howard served his country in the U.S. Air Force as a Medical/Surgical Technician in Topeka, Ft. Sam Houston and North Africa. He was employed by Goodyear Tire Company and owned his own business, Highland Park Energy Management for 25 years.
