September 1, 1921 - January 26, 2013

Irene M. Glotzbach, 91, of Topeka, died Saturday, January 26, 2013 at Brewster Place. She was born on September 1, 1921, in Berryton, the daughter of Frank and Katherine (Ingenthron) Renyer. She attended a one-room school near Berryton, where she became the first three-time Shawnee County Spelling Bee champion. Irene worked at Santa Fe RR, and later, at Southwestern Bell Telephone, where she retired in 1988. She married Herbert J. Glotzbach on January 26, 1943. She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband, Herb, in 1977 son, David and infant son, Thomas. She is survived by son, Mike (Caroll) Glotzbach; daughter, Barbara (Larry) Shipman all of Topeka; son, Edward (Julie) Glotzbach of St. Louis; and daughter, Susan Sackman (Bill Herbert) of Herndon VA; sister-in-law, Edith Sack of St. Marys; sister-in-law, JoAnn (Dale) Miller of Topeka; and brother-in-law, Dennis (Ruby) Glotzbach of Topeka; eight grandchildren, six step-grandchildren, 18 great-grandchildren, and six step-great grandchildren. Spending time with family was a special delight for her. Irene also volunteered for many years at St. Francis Hospital, including the heart pillow ministry; and was an avid bridge and pitch player, participating in many tournaments and marathons.
