October 3, 1923 - January 9, 2014

Isaac E. "Ike" Walden, 90, Topeka, died January 6, 2014. Ike was born October 3, 1923, in Coles County, Illinois, the son of Joe and Mary Curry Walden. Ike was a veteran of WWII, serving his country from October 3, 1943 through February 29, 1946, as an Air Force pilot. Later he was employed by General Electric Corporation and Westinghouse Electric Corporation for a total of 33 years. He spent that time in the lamp division of the companies. Ike retired in 1980. Ike married Jean L. Lunan in 1946. She passed away in 1979. On May 29, 1980, Ike and Beverly J. Howard were married at Fredonia, Kansas. She survives of the home.
