



## J. Louise Montgomery

October 6, 1928 - June 2, 2024

J. Louise Montgomery, 95, Auburn, Kansas, passed away on June 2, 2024.

Louise was born October 6, 1928, in Picher, Oklahoma, the daughter of Walter Louis and Ruth Ann Bryan Blout. Her early life was spent in Oklahoma, Kansas and Missouri, graduating from Cherokee County Community High School in Columbus, Kansas in 1947. After graduation, she went to Topeka, Kansas to work for the State of Kansas. She had also worked at Sears and Security State Bank of Auburn. Louise married Dale Porter on October 30, 1948, and they moved to Auburn, Kansas. The couple had three sons, Louis, Wayne, and Dean. Louis died on July 4, 1972. Dale died April 2, 1974.

Louise married Glenn Montgomery on August 16, 1975. He passed away on August 24, 2000. She loved volunteering at the Auburn Library and St. Francis surgical waiting room. Louise was a former member of the United Methodist Church of Auburn before they closed and was an active current member of the Auburn Presbyterian Church.

Louise is survived by her children, Wayne Porter, Dean Porter, both of Wakarusa, Kansas, Don Montgomery (Karen), Burlingame, Kansas, Susan Henning (Bill), Bartlesville, Oklahoma; 12 grandchildren; 17 great-grandchildren; and three great-great-grandchildren. She was also preceded in death by her parents, an older brother, and daughter-in-law, Jeanne Porter on

November 25, 2019.
