Jack N. Allman, age 83, Topeka, passed away Wednesday, May 6, 2009 at his home. He was born November 25, 1925 in Kansas City, MO to Theodore and Natalie Pryor Allman. He graduated from Scranton High School in 1943 and enlisted in the Navy. He trained at Great Lakes Naval Station after which he was stationed in the Philippines and the South Pacific until 1946. He went to work for IBM in 1952 and worked there as a customer engineer for 35 years. He married Lois Whitmore on November 26, 1949 in Osage City, KS. She passed away in 1958. He married Mary Elizabeth Dick on October 16, 1959 in Topeka. They moved to Manhattan, KS in 1961 where Jack continued to work for IBM until he retired in 1987. They moved back to Topeka in 1997. Jack enjoyed boating, quarter midgets, motorcycles, square dancing, wood carving and many other hobbies. He was a former member of Kaw Valley Wood Carvers. He was preceded in death by his wife, Mary, who died on September 3, 2005. He is survived by two sons, Bill Allman and his wife Judy, Topeka; and David Allman, Leavenworth; a grandson, Bruce Allman and his wife Ginger, Wichita; a granddaughter, Jennifer Weiglein, Wichita; a grandson, Dawson Raines, Kearney MO; two great grandsons, Peyton Allman and Owen Allman, Wichita; and a sister, Betty Krutsinger, Tulsa, OK. A memorial service will be held 11:00 a.m. Monday at Mount Hope Cemetery Chapel. Private inurnment will follow.
