Jack B. Blow, 83, Topeka, Kansas, passed away on Saturday, August 20, 2022.

Jack was born on February 17, 1939, in Reading, Kansas, the son of Harry and Agnes (Best) Blow. He graduated from Reading High School in 1957. Jack married Linda Feltner on December 21, 1958. His dream was to be a Kansas Highway Patrolman and in 1970, that dream came true. Jack retired after serving for over 30 years. He had been an active church member at Countryside United Methodist Church for many years. Jack was known around his neighborhood as “Mr. Fixit.” He loved to be outside, fixing things for family and friends, maintaining an immaculate lawn, and sharing his gift of service. Jack and Linda enjoyed going on road trips around the United States and going on cruises together. Jack made sure to let his wife, his children and their spouses know how much he loved and valued them.

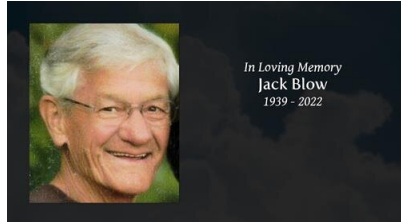
