James Franks, 90, Topeka, Kansas, passed away on Monday, November 13, 2023.

James was born May 18, 1933, in Call, Texas, the son of Robert and Johnnie Bell Franks. He married Elizabeth “Betty” Franks on May 18, 1957. In 1955, Jim joined the United States Army, serving over 20 years and retiring in 1974 as First Sergeant. He did a tour in Korea (1956) and two in Vietnam (1965-1966, 1968-1969). After retirement from the Army, Jim worked at Payless Cashways, owned his own roofing and concrete business for 10 years, and then at the State Animal Resource Department for 10 years.

Jim was a member of the Knights of Columbus Council No. 534 and James W. Gibbons Fourth Degree Assembly 286, served 20 years as an usher at Mater Dei Holy Name Catholic Church, and served 10 years as an usher at Mother Teresa of Calcutta Catholic Church.

Jim and Betty went country and western dancing every Saturday night for over 30 years. Jim loved their dog GiGi, gardening, bingo, and travelling to all 50 states.

Jim is survived by his wife, Betty; children, Ricky Franks, Michael Franks (Susan), and Pamela Franks (Craig Miller); grandchildren, Shannon, Casey,

Sally, Jeff, Michael and Ilona; five great-grandchildren; and one great-great-grandchild. He was preceded in death by his parents, and siblings, Margie Griner, Ed Franks, and John Franks.
