James T. Lane, Sr., 85, formerly of Topeka, passed away at Lawrence Memorial Hospital Tuesday, November 11, 2014. Jim was born January 6, 1929, in Abilene, Texas, the son of Ralph and Hazel Richardson Lane. He enlisted in the Navy in 1948, and was trained as a hospital corpsman. He was transferred to the Marine Corps in preparation for being sent to Korea. He was later transferred back to the Navy and was honorably discharged in 1952. On April 20, 1963, Jim and Maureen Rossiter were united in marriage at Holy Name Church. They enjoyed over 51 years together. They were long time members of Mater Dei Holy Name Church. Jim had a 38 year career as an administrator and retired from the Kansas Department of Revenue. Jim's survivors include his wife, Maureen; children, Laurie McPeck (Brian), Jim Lane, Jr. (Julie), Susan Valesano (Jon), Colleen Toliver (Steve), Dennis Lane, Patricia LaRue (Randy), and Bill Lane (Stacey); 17 grandchildren; siblings, David Lane (Peggy) and Elsie Parks (James); and nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his first wife, Jeanne Lane, and siblings, R.J., John, Forrest, Luella Long and Virginia Bousquet.
