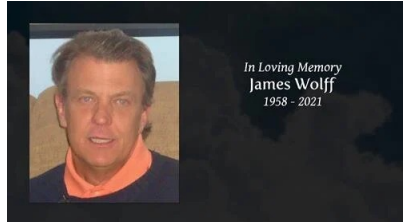

My heart goes out to you both. I am also mourning your dad. I loved him like a brother. We didn't see much of each other since the two of you were born, except at family events and when Laura was home, but he and I were extremely close growing up. My mother, David and I went to visit the family in Decatur when Jim and I were both five years old and -- only seven months apart in age -- we instantly bonded. I also adored Barbara as the big sister I never had, and Becky to some extent, although five years age difference and all the time she spent in sports meant we had less in common. She and Jim were two of a kind, though. After they moved back to Topeka, we spent practically every weekend together, playing around their house and at Gage Park when they lived right across the street, or running around White Lakes when it first opened. Your dad and the girls lived with my family for about a month when Uncle Gene was in the hospital following his aneurysm, then he stayed with us again after the fire while Aunt Jeane was recovering in the hospital. Gene and Laura stayed with the grandparents, but it was better for Jim to be amongst a larger family group where he had more loving attention to comfort him. And he got it.

Aside from the tragedies in our lives, he and I also had a lot of fun together. Yet, people can tend to grow apart as they get older, and his sports took him away from home a lot of the time I was at your grandparents' house over the years. So we saw less and less of each other, especially after he met your mother, fell head over heels in love and spent all his free time with her. Then marriage, children and work took all of his time and mine, as they can. I truly wish we had stayed in closer touch, but even if we rarely actually saw each other, we still had an emotional tie that will never be broken.

He was a good guy who loved both of you very deeply and was extremely proud of you. Hold onto that and cherish your memories of good times. That is what matters.

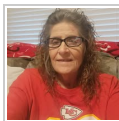
