April 16, 1938 - September 15, 2018

Jane Louise Stromberg Kurtz Beamand, 80, Topeka, Kansas, passed away Saturday, September 15, 2018.

Jane was born April 16, 1938, in Cincinnati, Ohio, the daughter of Hans Bernard Severin Stromberg and Katherine Louise Davis Stromberg. She graduated from Woodward High School in 1956 and earned her bachelor's and nursing degrees from Cincinnati School of Nursing.

On June 8, 1963, Jane and Edward Gray Kurtz were united in marriage. He died in 1996. On September 9, 1999 at 9 a.m., Jane and Willard Waldo Beamand were married. He passed in 2008.

Jane was active in nursing for 50 years, retiring at the age of 72. She was dedicated to her profession and had great compassion. She was 26 years and 9 month cancer survivor.
