Jesse Thomas Schulz, 46, Newton, Kansas, (formerly of Topeka, Kansas) passed away Saturday, February 18, 2023.

Jesse was born July 14, 1976, in Topeka to Kathy Rundell and Rick Schulz. He spent most of his life in Topeka where he attended Holy Name Catholic Grade School and was a 1994 graduate of Hayden High School. Jesse was a longtime carpenter and most recently worked for Masterbrand Cabinets in Newton. He loved dogs, had pristine taste in electric guitars and loved with his whole heart. Like so many others, Jesse battled addiction to the end.

Jesse is survived by his maternal grandmother, Virginia Rundell, of Topeka. "Granny" was an everlasting and devoted fixture in his life. He is also survived by a large number of aunts and uncles as well as an even larger group of cousins whom he called on as brothers, sisters and friends. He will be missed by loyal and faithful friends from his school years as well. Jesse was preceded in death by his mother, father and his infant sister, Lyndsay Kathleen Schulz.
