Jessie Louise Russell, 94, Topeka, Kansas, passed away in peace to join her Lord on March 11, 2025, at the House at Midland Care. The family thanks the staff at Stormont Vail Hospital and the House at Midland Care for the care, love, and support provided to Jessie.
