Dr. Joe T. Casper, Jr. 86, Topeka, died on Thursday January 29, 2009 at Midland Hospice. He was born December 22, 1922 in Queen City MO to Dr. Joe T. Casper and Marian Veal Casper. Dr. Casper is a graduate of Topeka High School, Washburn University and the University of Missouri Kansas City Dental School. Dr. Casper practiced dentistry for 34 years in Topeka, specializing in orthodontics. He was a veteran of WWII (Navy) and the Korean War (Army). He was a member of the Kappa Sigma Fraternity and the Downtown Topeka Rotary Club, where he was a Paul Harris Fellow. Dr. Casper was a board member emeritus for the Kansas State Historical Society and a past president of the Shawnee County Historical Society. He was married to Betty McEnroe on August 24, 1946 in Topeka. She survives. He is also survived by his children, Joe T. Casper III (Chris) of Mandeville LA, Adrienne C. Evans and Robert W. Casper (Brenda), of Topeka; five grandchildren, J.T. Casper IV (Bliss) Mandeville LA, Meg Casper, Baton Rouge LA, Jennifer Evans, Miami FL, Brooke Lewis (Kevin) Olathe KS, Nicholas Casper, Topeka; and two great-grandchildren. Funeral service will be at 2 p.m. Tuesday at Most Pure Heart of Mary Church where family will greet friends from 1 until 2 p.m. Burial will follow at Mt. Calvary Cemetery.
