John Leslie Brown, 94, Auburn, Kansas, passed away on Wednesday, April 8, 2026.

John was born in Abilene, Kansas, the son of Lloyd and Mabel Robinson Brown. He was raised in Barnes, Kansas by his grandmother, Lena Grimes, and attended Barnes High School. He was drafted into the United States Army and served in Korea with the 24th Infantry. John married Mary Lou Reed in Fairbury, Nebraska on September 12, 1955; she preceded him in death in 2023. He retired from Goodyear and then worked for 24 years for the Kaw Valley Girl Scout Council as a Camp Ranger at Camp Daisy Hindman. During his time as a Camp Ranger, he developed a skill for tinkering and small engine repair and did this at his home for a number of years. John enjoyed birdwatching, college basketball, socializing, being ornery and telling lots of one-liners. He was a member of the American Legion.

John is survived by his children, Kevin Brown, Lucinda Welch (Pat) and Lisa Brown; four grandchildren; nine great-grandchildren; three great-great-grandchildren; and many nieces and nephews. He was also preceded in death by his parents and a brother.
