John (Jack) Harold DeLeon age 74 of Topeka KS, passed away March 10, 2014. He was born on April 25, 1939, in Clearfield PA the only child of Harold John and Leona DeLeon. Both parents are deceased. John grew up in Pennsylvania and graduated from Clearfield Pennsylvania High School in 1957 and Penn State University in 1961 with a degree in Mining Engineering. After graduating from college, John worked for several companies in manufacturing, engineering, production and plant management. During this period the family lived in nine states. In 1975 after closing down Lehigh Cement Company in Florida the family moved to Cedar Rapids, Iowa and began work for Martin Marietta Corporation. John and family were transferred to Des Moines IA and finally to Topeka KS. John worked with Martin Marietta; they merged with Lockheed to form Lockheed Martin Corporation and later spun off Martin Marietta Materials Corporation. John worked for them for 30 years, retiring the first part of 2005 as Director of Operation Services. John was an active member of Central Church of Christ. John is survived by his wife of 52 years Beverly Beth (Straw), two married daughters Kimberly Shumate (Adam) and Lesley Elliott (James), and three grand children Nathan Shumate, John Barry Elliott and Anna JoBeth Elliott. The visitation will be held at the Central Church of Christ at 10:00 a.m. with a memorial service following at 11:00 a.m. Saturday, March 15, 2014.
