John C. "Jack" Kennedy, age 72, of Topeka, passed away September 18, 2006 at his home. John was born September 20, 1933, in Emmett KS to John E. and Agnes R. Grace Kennedy. John graduated from Hayden High School in 1953. He married Martha Browning August 27, 1955 at the Assumption Church. She survives. Other survivors include, his sons and daughters-in-law, Chris and Paula Kennedy, John and Nancy Kennedy, Matt and Terri Kennedy, all of Topeka, and Sam and Leanne Kennedy, Geneva IL; 15 grandchildren; 3 great-grandchildren; his brother, Max Kennedy, and his sister, Mary Kay Rabe, Topeka. He was preceded in death by his brother Bill and his sister Joane Kennedy. John worked for SWB and AT&T for 32 years before retiring in 1988.
