John Pierce "JP" MacMillan, 87, Topeka, Kansas, passed away on Friday, July 22, 2022. He was born May 28, 1935, in Meriden, Connecticut, the son of Edward R. and Eileen O'Brien MacMillan.

John worked for the Kansas Department of Transportation. He and his wife, Dorrie, owned and operated Dor-Macs' Repair for many years. John and Dorris Percival were married in Eureka Springs, Arkansas on September 5, 1953. This union was blessed by the Catholic Church on May 3, 1954, at Fairchild Air Force Base in Spokane, Washington. She preceded him in death on May 13, 2010.
