



## John Weaver

August 2, 1919 - February 20, 2006

John A. Weaver, 86, Topeka, passed away Mon., Feb. 20, 2006.

Mr. Weaver was born Aug. 2, 1919 in Galveston TX, the son of Arthur and Helen Valentine Koehler Weaver. His family moved to Topeka where he attended Topeka High School, graduating in 1938. John played baseball in high school and then pitched for a semi-pro team. He went to work for Topeka Newspaper Printing Co., the operating agent for the Topeka Daily Capital and Topeka State Journal in 1944 as an office boy. Mr. Weaver joined the advertising sales staff and retired after 40 years as a sales-marketing executive for the Topeka Capital Journal. On June 25, 1947, John and Mary Ann Renyer were married in Topeka and are the parents of seven children. He was Boy Scout Master of Troop 26 at Holy Name Church for about 8 years in the 1960s. He was a member of Christ the King Church, Knights of Columbus, third degree, Council 534. His hobbies included bowling, dancing, golf and outdoor activities. Most recently he enjoyed searching garage sales for and repairing old lawnmowers.

Mr. Weaver is survived by his wife, Mary Ann, of the home; children, James Weaver, Lecompton, Gregory Weaver, Patrick Weaver, Mark Weaver, Mary Lisa Weaver, all of Topeka, and Paul Weaver, Murray KY; a brother, Donald A. Weaver; and a sister, Gloria Byers, both of Topeka; 12 grandchildren and 1 great-grandchild. He was preceded in death by a son, Cpl. John Forrest

Mr. Weaver will lie in state from 3 to 8 p.m. Wed. at Kevin Brennan Family Funeral Home, 2801 SW Urish Rd, Topeka KS 66614, where family will greet friends from 6 to 8 p.m. A parish rosary will be prayed at 6 p.m. at the funeral home.
