Joseph George Meier, Jr., 91, of Topeka, Kansas died Friday, February 6, 2026, at Midland Hospice Care. He was born on March 7, 1934, in Topeka, the son of Joseph George Meier, Sr., and Rose Marie Lambrecht.

Joseph George married Shirley Louise Deiter on April 11, 1959. She died July 5, 1974.
