John Ingenthron, 73, died peacefully at his home on Saturday, March 19, 2005.

He was born April 26, 1931 in Topeka, the son of George and Elizabeth Andes Ingenthron.

John grew up in Topeka, attending Sacred Heart School and Hayden High School.

He entered the United States Navy in 1951 and became a member of the Ancient Order of The Deep May 31, 1953. He served as a tailgunner in the Korean War. He received an honorable discharge in 1954.

Upon returning to Topeka, he opened several businesses including the Rocket Tavern, the Party Shack and the Pizza Parlor. He was an honorary member of the North Topeka Businessmen's Club. He joined The Topeka Fire Department in 1960 and was a member of The International Association of Fire Fighters, Local 83. He was one of the original members of the flying squad. He was promoted to Captain in 1980 and retired in 1986.

He was a member of Sacred Heart Church. He married Valerie Nicholas Ingenthron August 2, 1958. She survives of the home. John was preceded in death by sisters, Lucille Stier, Helen Abate, and Millie Crawford, one brother Raymond Ingenthron and a son, Bill Ingenthron.

Survivors include 2 sons, George, his wife Yessica and their son Jorge Ingenthron, Bocas Del Toro, Panama and Joseph Ingenthron, Topeka, 6
