



## Josephine C. Reilly

January 1, 1919 - April 1, 2013

Josephine Christina Reilly, 93, Topeka, passed away Mon., Mar. 25, 2013. Josephine was born Nov. 16, 1919, in Delia KS, the daughter of Joseph Saia and Christena (Kalcik) Saia. She graduated from St. Anthony nursing school in Sabetha KS in May of 1943. Josephine worked for St. Luke's Hospital in Kansas City as a RN in surgery. On Jan. 21, 1947, Josephine and Joseph Reilly were united in marriage; he preceded her in death in 1982. In 1952 she moved to Topeka, where she worked for St. Francis hospital as a RN in surgery from 1962 until she retired in 1989. She was a member of Most Pure Heart parish, Mater Dei Holy Name parish, Ladies of Columbus, AORN, and the Moose Lodge. Josephine enjoyed traveling and watching sports with her family. Survivors include her children; Debbie, Nick and Tim, as well as four grandchildren and six great-grandchildren.
